# HOW TO GET YOUR NEVADA INSURANCE LICENSE

# **Individual Resident Producer Requirements**

To qualify for a resident Nevada state insurance producer license, the applicant must satisfy the following requirements:

- Be 18 years of age or older
- Be a resident of the state of Nevada
- Pass a written examination and file a license application online
- Submit a set of fingerprints

# **PreLicense Education**

Although prelicensing education is not required in Nevada, those looking to earn an insurance license have a significantly higher chance of passing their licensing exam when they complete 1<sup>st</sup> Academy School of Insurance's exam prep courses. Give yourself the best chance to pass before you take the state exam.

## Nevada Pre-License Exam Prep Course

### Prelicense Course Delivery

To earn a Nevada insurance license, you must first pass a state licensing exam for each desired line of authority. 1<sup>st</sup> Academy School of Insurance's exam prep content is based directly on the Nevada licensing exams, so you will be prepared to pass the first time.

Effective January 1, 2020, Prelicensing Education courses will no longer be required for all license types except bail. However, achieving a passing score on a Pearson VUE exam is still required to qualify for Nevada Insurance licenses. 1<sup>st</sup> Academy School of Insurance can assist you to be fully prepared for success in passing the Nevada Insurance licensing exam.

### Nevada Insurance License Exam Requirements

License Application Process

Apply Online: new resident can submit their application online by visiting <u>nipr.com</u>

1. **Register for the State Exam**: Register online by visiting <u>pearsonvue.com/nv</u> or by calling (800) 274-2609.

The Exam fee is: 1. Single Line = \$51.00 and 2. Double Line = \$61.00.

**Materials Needed to Apply:** Candidates must present two forms of current signature identification. The name on the identification must exactly match the name on the registration. The primary identification must be government issued and photo-bearing with a signature, and the secondary identification must contain a valid signature. Identification must be in English. Exam Format: Applicants must pass the state licensing exam with an 80% or higher to file a license application.

- File license application: License application can be submitted online through <u>NIPR</u>. Once you have submitted your application to the Division, you should log back into the application system using your candidate transaction number to attach supporting documentation to your online application.
- 3. **Fingerprinting Process:** Candidates may only call MorphoTrust, USA<sup>™</sup> at 866-761-8069 to make fingerprint reservation. Pearson VUE cannot make the reservation for you. WALK-IN digital fingerprints will be available at IdentoGO by MorphoTrust, USA <sup>™</sup>locations only NOT Pearson VUE test centers. Fingerprint Background Waiver can be obtained by visiting <a href="https://www.asisvcs.com/publications/pdf/122918.pdf">https://www.asisvcs.com/publications/pdf/122918.pdf</a>. The fingerprinting fee is \$55.00.

## Non-Resident Nevada Pre-License Exam Prep Requirements

### Non-Resident License Requirements

Applicant must be licensed in good standing in home state for all lines for which you are applying, and submit an application and appropriate licensing fees online.

### License Application Process

Nonresident individuals applying for a producer license must apply electronically through <u>Sircon</u> <u>Compliance Express</u> or through the <u>NIPR</u>. Electronic transaction fees apply. Effective July 1, 2015, the licensing fee will be reduced to \$185, plus online processing fees. Applicants requiring an agency affiliation must pay an additional \$50 for each affiliation. Those applicants applying through Sircon may print their license online for free for up to 30 days after the license is issued.
